South Lakeland Orchard Group's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Policy

SLOG holds a limited amount of personal information concerning its members. Specifically, this includes names, addresses, postcodes, telephone numbers and email addresses, joining date and membership category (Individual, Household or Group). This data is provided by each member when first joining SLOG. It is held in electronic format and can be accessed by the Chairman, Treasurer and Membership Secretary of SLOG.

It is used only for SLOG administration and communications, e.g. to maintain up to date subscription records, to email or post quarterly newsletters and to provide information to members about SLOG events and related information. It is never made available to third parties. In addition, the National Trust at Sizergh Castle holds data provided by members hiring the apple press. This data is held in a secure digital filing system, accessed only by Sizergh Staff.

If a member wishes to amend or withdraw their personal information held by SLOG, they may do so by notifying the Membership Secretary by email, who will act upon their instruction and confirm such action to the member upon completion.
